



## **DECISION ECSEL-ED 2014-021 OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**

### **Relating to a Delegation Act for Authorising Officer by Delegation**

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ECSEL JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to the Statutes of Council Regulation (EU) No 561/2014 establishing the ECSEL Joint Undertaking (JU) and in particular to Article 9.3;

Having regard to ECSEL Financial Rules (decision GB-2014.09) and in particular to Article 16,

WHEREAS,

- 1) The Executive Director of the ECSEL Joint Undertaking shall perform the duties of authorising officer;
- 2) The Executive Director may delegate the powers of budget implementation to staff of the ECSEL JU;
- 3) The budget implementation responsibilities apply mutatis mutandis to the authorising officers by delegation,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

#### *Article 1*

The powers of budget implementation carried out on the basis of both paper documents signed manually, and the computerised management system signed electronically for the budgetary year 2014, for all fund sources, and until 31 December 2014, are hereby delegated to Marc Jeuniaux, Head of Administration of the ECSEL JU.

Marc Jeuniaux shall act as Authorising Officer by Delegation for all budget lines related to ECSEL JU.

Marc Jeuniaux shall ensure that operations are initiated and verified adequately (ex-ante and if appropriate ex-post) in accordance with ECSEL Financial Rules.

*Article 2*

This decision repeals decision ED 2014 018.

The decision shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
