



DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE ECSEL JOINT UNDERTAKING

Amending the ECSEL Work Plan for the year 2018

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE ECSEL JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) No 561/2014 of 6 May 2014 establishing the ECSEL Joint Undertaking¹,

Having regard to the Statutes of the Joint Undertaking as annexed to Council Regulation (EC) No 561/2014, and in particular Articles 1(e), 7§3 (k) and 21(2),

Having regard to decision ECSEL GB 2018.100 amending the work plan 2018, dated 15 February 2018,

WHEREAS:

- 1) There is an obligation stemming from the H2020 2018-2020 work plan: "Appropriateness of the allocation of tasks, ensuring that all participants have a valid role and adequate resources in the project to fulfil that role". In order to evaluate this, the role (including impact) of each partner must be described. Therefore, the ECSEL Office proposes to increase the maximum page limits for FPP stage from 60 to 100 for the two criteria impact and implementation in order not to penalize the larger consortia.
- 2) Since its amendment on 15 February 2018, some updates should be introduced in the work plan – the complete list of changes is indicated in the history of changes table (page 2 of the Annual Work Plan 2018)
- 3) The Governing Board shall adopt the amended work plan;

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The amended work plan for the year 2018, as annexed to this decision, is hereby adopted. It shall be published on the website of the ECSEL Joint Undertaking and on the H2020 single portal for participants.

Article 2

Decision ECSEL GB 2018.100 is hereby repealed and replaced by this Decision.
